**FEBRUARY 2012 SPIRIT OF THE MONTH
BOWMORE 12 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT SCOTCH**

Founded over two centuries ago in 1779, Bowmore is the first recorded distillery on Islay (pronounced 'eye-la') and one of the oldest in the whole of Scotland. Islay malts are renowned for their *peaty smokiness* and Bowmore is no exception. We carefully smoke our malt in a peat-fired kiln, just as our ancestors did over 200 years ago. Final character of the Bowmore Single Malt is developed in the famous seaside vaults, where their whiskies rest quietly *below sea level* in the finest Spanish and American oak casks.

Bowmore 12 has a place in many hearts as Islay's 'medium-peated' malt. A pronounced iodine character with plenty of pepper, yet the malt is balanced and smooth as well as smoky.

Nose: Serious and smoky with a sweet undercurrent. Smokiness balanced by heather honey sweetness. Peaty, lemon, pears and honey. Body: Medium. Color: Warm Amber. Taste: Smoky and sweet start, matches the nose very well. Very smooth on the surface, smoky undercurrent determines the tone of the whisky.

Finish: Long, complex and satisfying

2008 A. MANO PRIMITIVO (Italian Red Zinfandel) PUGLIA, ITALY

WINE NOTES - A-Mano is a stunning example of a concentrated, elegant, rich, deep, dark purple wine. The raspberries jump out of the glass to herald the aromas to follow, blueberry, tar, leather, anise and cedar. The complexity evolves and the soft, velvety tannins linger on the long, long finish. This is a wine that reveals a new treasure with each sip.

Sweet, forward, and succulent, this easy-going effort delivers black pepper and bitter sweet chocolate in its fruit-filled finish. Drink it over the next 3-4 years.

CODORNIU RESERVA RAVENTOS BRUT CAVA - SPARKLING WINE - SPAIN

WINERY NOTES - For years Codorníu Selección Raventós was chosen for the private enjoyment of the Raventós family – the fruit of a winemaking tradition of 18 generations. On the occasion of the 125th anniversary of the first bottle of sparkling wine to be produced by Josep Raventós in 1872, the product was made available commercially.

A brut with a brilliant straw yellow colour and fine, delicate and persistent bubbles, it has aromas of pineapple and stone fruit, together with more classic aromas such as citrus and apple from the traditional varieties. Also prominent are aromas from ageing on yeast lees (dried fruit, honey, toast, etc). On the palate, Selección

Raventós has a creamy texture and good body, with a refreshing and persistent mouthfeel.

2008 GUNDLACH-BUNDSCHU - CABERNET SAUVIGNON - ESTATE VINEYARD - SONOMA VALLEY

2007 KALLFELZ ESTATE - SINGLE VINEYARD - RIESLING KABINETT - GERMANY

WINERY NOTES - The estate has been family owned for the last 100 years. Steep vineyard sites, low yielding vines and a grey slate sub soil are the givens for Kallfelz Riesling Wines. Intense bouquet with ripe and matured fruit aromas. This wine has a rich, long lasting aftertaste.

2008 COPPOLA DIRECTOR'S ZINFANDEL

Winemaker Notes - Small amounts of Petite Sirah were added to our Zinfandel as a means of providing additional structure and balance to the solid core of fruit. We then aged the wine in French oak barrels, using a combination of new and used oak, and let that determine the final blend.

Tasting Notes -This wine is tremendously rich and concentrated. With an intense fragrance of black cherries, boysenberry syrup, pepper and spice, the wine offers a velvety palate and flavors of wild raspberries, plums and English toffee. Pairs beautifully with barbecued spare ribs, lamb chops or baked ziti. Skirt steak, penne with sausage and sage, or cheddar-topped potatoes.

2007 VILLA BANFI BELNERO - MONTALCINO, ITALY

DESCRIPTION - Colour: intense and deep mauve red. Bouquet: gentle aromas with notes of vanilla, tobacco and coffee, and also fruity hints of cherry jam and prunes. Taste: powerful structure with soft and well balanced tannins.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES - Belnero is the expression of the solid and indissoluble connection of Castello Banfi with Montalcino territory. This wine celebrates the experience and passion behind Castello Banfi's 30-year pursuit of excellence in the vineyard as well as in the winery. Belnero is driven by the Sangiovese grape, the emblematic varietal of Montalcino tradition that was studied and perfected through Banfi's decades of research, and complemented with small percentages of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot which find on our estate in southern Tuscany their most favorable habitat. Belnero, with its powerful and well balanced structure, is ideal for a long aging.

2007 ALLEGRINI PALAZZO DELLA TORRE - VERONA, ITALY

90 PTS. WINE ADVOCATE - Enticing scents of chocolate, espresso, dark fruit, licorice and new leather emerge from the boisterous 2007 Palazzo della Torre. The fruit is sumptuous as always, but in 2007 Palazzo della Torre is not quite as approachable upon release as it usually is. Another year or two in bottle should help smooth some of the slightly rough edges that are present today. There is enough balance and elegance in the finish to suggest this will drink well for a number of years. Palazzo della Torre is made from 70% Corvina, 25% Rondinella and 5% Sangiovese, all traditional Veneto grapes. Approximately 30% of the fruit is air-dried, Amarone-style. The fermenting juice from those grapes is added to the rest of the juice to give the wine an extra dimension of richness and body. Anticipated maturity: 2012-2017.

2003 QUINTA DE LA ROSA "LBV" (Late Bottle Vintage) PORT

WINERY NOTES - This port comes from an excellent, generally declared vintage year which was perfect for LBVs as well. An authentic explosion of aromatic fruit flavors. It is an enormous LBV which retains its elegance due to its soft tannins and overall fruit. It is very rich and irresistibly seductive.

LBV Definition - The wine is from a single harvest and the year is usually stated on the bottle. The wine is usually aged in wood for 4 to 6 years. LBV port is very quaffable and more accessible than a true Vintage Port. The wines are intended to be drunk early, and do not have much aging potential.

2004 QUINTA DE LA ROSA VINTAGE PORT

93 PTS. WINE ENTHUSIAST - A finely structured, impressively elegant wine, packed with dark fruit skin flavors, heavy with tannins and delicious perfumed fruit. While it is rich, it is also dry, suggesting excellent aging potential.

Definition - Vintage Port is the premium port. After the wine is produced it is aged in barrel for 2 to 3 years and is bottled without filtering. It is designed to be laid down for a long period of time to allow aging to improve the wine.
