**2009 BYRON - PINOT NOIR - SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA**

**WINERY NOTES** - Byron's estate vineyard is the site of Santa Barbara County's first commercial

vineyard, planted in 1964 by Uriel Nielson. For the past two decades its trials and experiments on clones, rootstocks and trellising have helped establish cool-climate farming protocols throughout California's coastal winegrowing regions. Today, Byron produces renowned Pinot Noirs and Chardonnays from its estate and other marquee vineyards in Santa Barbara County. The 2009 vintage was relatively dry, warm and trouble free. The small clusters and miniscule berries produced a wine that is deep, lush and neatly balanced. The dominant themes are dark berries, cherries, rose petal, red plum, brown spice and smoke. This is a forward, approachable wine that displays the beautiful floral/mineral character typical of Santa Barbara Pinot Noir. Aged 8 months in 100% French oak (20% new). Alcohol 13.5%.

**2007 TAPENA GARNACHA - SPAIN**

Garnacha (gar-NA-chah) was born in Spain, but is now known to most of the world as Grenache - think Rhone style wines. Today, Garnacha is the most widely planted red wine grape in Spain. A terrific food wine, Tapeña Garnacha is spicy and seductive, with a lovely garnet color and lingering flavors. Its brilliant violet hue and seductive nose whisper 'try me, now' as you bring the wine to your lips. In the mouth, there is a rush of dark fruit with an underlying bright spice, including hints of rosemary, thyme and just a trace of sage. As the wine opens on the palate there is an intense minerality. Tapeña Garnacha is full-bodied, but still lively, with rounded tannins which combine with the fruit to produce a velvet finish.
