Color: Golden Yellow

Nose: Full and fruity aroma with a citrus – spiciness taste

Taste: Well structured with honey notes. A tang of oranges and lemons, a strong malt presence that balances well with the oily sweetness.

Finish: A long finish with the malt becoming more dominant to the end without the soft fruits and honey, which helped make up the middle.

2007 TANGLEY OAKS - MERLOT LOT#8 - NAPA

WINERY NOTES - Each year the Tangley Oaks winemakers select the single lot that has developed into the truest example of the esteemed Napa Valley and the Merlot grape.

This well balanced Napa Valley Merlot exhibits red berry and plum flavors along with notes of espresso and cassis. The wine was barrel aged in French oak for 20 months, allowing for a smooth, lush mouthfeel. With firm tannins and a lingering finish, the wine will pair well with grilled meats and game.

86 PTS. WINE SPECTATOR - Watermelon and strawberry flavors wind through this lively rosé. There's tangy acidity, and the finish is tinged with hints of spice and orange peel. Drink now.

2007 KENDALL-JACKSON - CHARDONNAY - CAMELOT HIGHLANDS ESTATE

93 PTS. ROBERT PARKER - The highest production comes from the 2007 Highland Estates Chardonnay Camelot Vineyard (3,700 cases), which exhibits abundant amounts of pineapple, honeysuckle, and peach along with hints of brioche and caramel. Its full-bodied, luscious finish exhibits a subtle note of oak. This Chardonnay should drink well for several years. As I wrote last year, despite a production of two million bottles of the Vintner's Reserve Chardonnay, 110,000 bottles of the Vintner's Reserve Merlot, and 170,000 bottles of the Vintner's Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, these are all good as well as value-priced wines. The third level in the Kendall-Jackson hierarchy is the Highland Estates cuvees, all essentially single vineyard wines from some of Jess Jackson's finest sites. The brilliance of the Chardonnays in this portfolio needs to be addressed.

2006 CUIVAISON - MOUNT VEEDER CABERNET SAUVIGNON

87 PTS. WINE ENTHUSIAST - Ripe, with pie-filling flavors of cherries, blackberries, blueberries and currants, and plenty of smoky oak. Lush, but not especially subtle. With its firm tannins, it could possibly age.

WINERY NOTES - Intense ruby red in color with aromas of mature red fruits, strawberries and cherries. On the palate the wine is fruity, juicy and fresh with firm tannins and a long, pleasant finish. Pair with Iberian appetizers, soft cheeses and red meats.

It shows a swirl of citrus, peach, apple and wildflower flavors that are frankly delicious, a classic California white wine at an everyday price.

WINEMAKER NOTES - Endes Vineyard with 85% Syrah and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon. Big ripe black spicy fruit, high quality Syrah nose, sweet fruit, great texture and balance with a nice finish. This wine was aged in barrels and it shows. A sexy wine and very high quality for this price.

2006 SAMSARA SYRAH - VERNA'S VINEYARD - SANTA BARBARA, CENTRAL COAST CALIFORNIA

87 PTS. ROBERT PARKER Some of the 2006 vintage's challenges are apparent in Samsara's 2006 Syrah Verna's Vineyard. Slightly herbal, lean, and austere, it resembles a so-so vintage of a French St.-Joseph rather than a classic Santa Barbara County Syrah. It exhibits a chalky minerality along with attractive, herbaceous, red cherry and red currant notes as well as good freshness and medium body.

2007 MANDRAROSSA - FIANO WHITE WINE - SICILIA, ITALY

WINEMAKER NOTES - Brilliant pale yellow with hints of green. Ripe tropical fruits and citrus aromas. Medium-bodied and dry with elegant balance. The fruit and citrus aromas on the nose evolve on the palate in an array of fruit flavors

2008 TERRAZAS - MALBEC - MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

86 PTS. WINE SPECTATOR - The 2008 Malbec is dark ruby-colored with a pleasant nose of cinnamon, violets, and black cherry. This leads to an easy-going, friendly wine with ripe fruit and spicy flavors. It can be enjoyed over the next three years.

2007 CARNEROS CREEK RESERVE PINOT NOIR

WINEMAKER NOTES - The 2007 Carneros Creek Reserve displays a dense ruby color with crimson at the center. Ripe Bing cherries leap forward in the nose, followed by red raspberry, and subtle spice. Oak is decidedly restrained, allowing the fruit to dominate the aromas. In the mouth, there is a youthful firmness with a note of minerality, leading to fresh cherry and a hint of clove. Again, oak is subtle and in the background, but lends a bit of tannin in the finish. The wine has a pleasing acidity that will create liveliness when paired with a meal, and will also allow for aging 4 to 6 years in a proper cellar.

2007 ROSEMOUNT - PINOT GRIGIO - AUSTRALIA

The Diamond Label Pinot Grigio is a wine with soft, yet generous, flavors. Citrus and tropical fruit notes follow from the nose onto the rounded palate, with lively acid adding to a finish of great length and flavor.

2007 BERINGER - KNIGHT'S VALLEY ALLUVIUM WHITE

89 PTS. WINE SPECTATOR - A bracing acidity and tart citrus, orange peel and peach flavors are pleasantly balanced with spice and campfire smoke nuances on a sleek frame, with a long finish. Sauvignon Blanc, Sémillon, Chardonnay and Viognier. Drink now through 2013. 8,500 cases made.

2006 TANGLEY OAKS - CHARDONNAY LOT 3 - SANTA BARBARA

WINEMAKER NOTES - Each year the Tangley Oaks winemakers select the single lot that has developed into the truest example of Santa Barbara County and the Chardonnay grape. The wine is only partially barrel fermented (36%) with the remaining wine aged in stainless steel. This lends itself to a slight oakiness that doesn't overpower the wine as many other California Chardonnays experience. Tangley Oaks Chardonnay delivers fresh pear aromas followed by baked apple flavors with hints of Meyer lemon, nutmeg and vanilla. It is refreshing with bright acidity, and will pair well with roasted chicken, pork loin or

veal.

2006 SOLAIRE BY ROBERT MONDAVI - CHARDONNAY SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS

WINEMAKER NOTES - Solaire by Robert Mondavi displays aromas and flavors of citrus, pear, mango, and freshly cut pineapple, supported by spicy and smoky nuances from 100% French oak. Aged for 13 months in a combination of new and one-year-old oak, this wine may be enjoyed upon release.
